# UCUES 2020 BASIC NEEDS STATISTICS FOOD SECURITY

Undergraduate student respondents who stated in the past 12 months:

The food they bought just didn't last, and they didn't have money to get more

### UCUES 2020 BASIC NEEDS STATISTICS HOUSING SECURITY

Undergraduate student respondents reported that in the last 12 months, they temporarily slept in the following places because they didn't have a home to return to:

## UCUES 2020 BASIC NEEDS STATISTICS HOUSING SECURITY

Undergraduate student respondents reported the following reasons for moving in the last 12 months:

# COVID-19

Undergraduate student respondents reported being concerned (very concerned/concerned) that:



**COVID-19** has affected learning effectively in the remote instruction environment



COVID-19 has affected doing well on tests and assignments in online courses



COVID-19 has affected their ability to meet their basic needs (food, housing, etc.)



Agree that UC Riverside is committed to student health and wellbeing during the COVID-19 pandemic



COVID-19 has affected being isolated from friends



Agree that they know how to protect themselves from COVID-19
